The Alexa Global Ranking took us from 1.8 million at the beginning of the year to 177,053. These indices have positioned us to serve you and your business better.

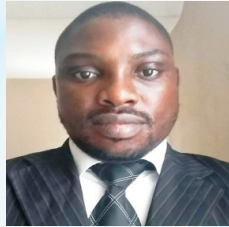
