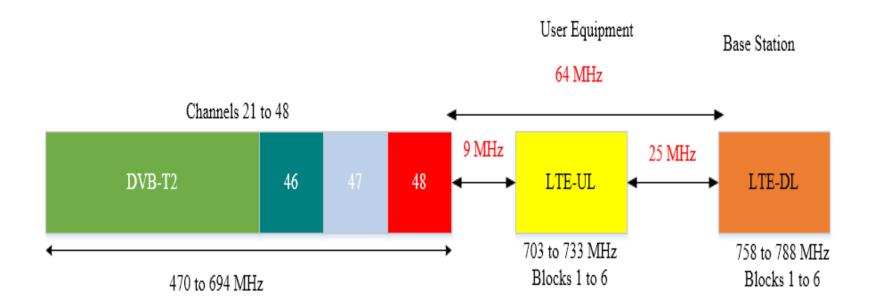

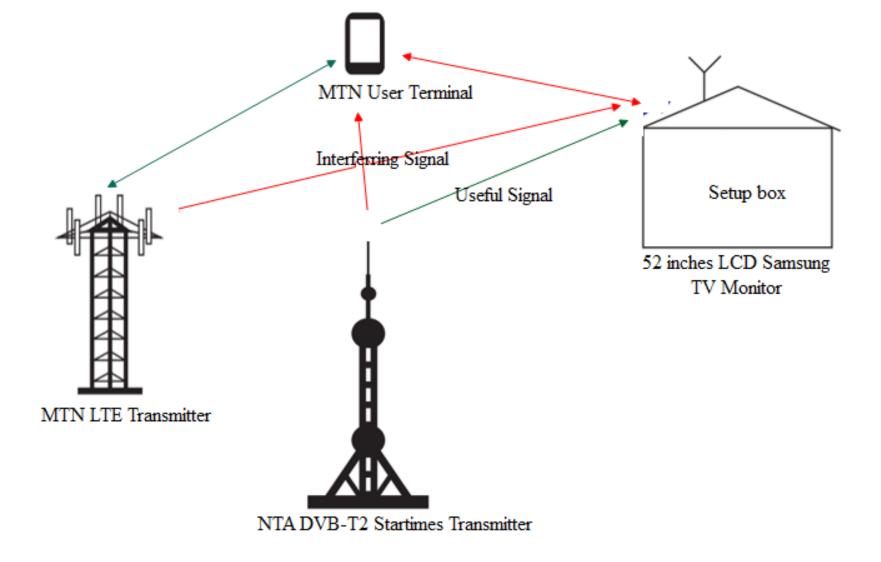

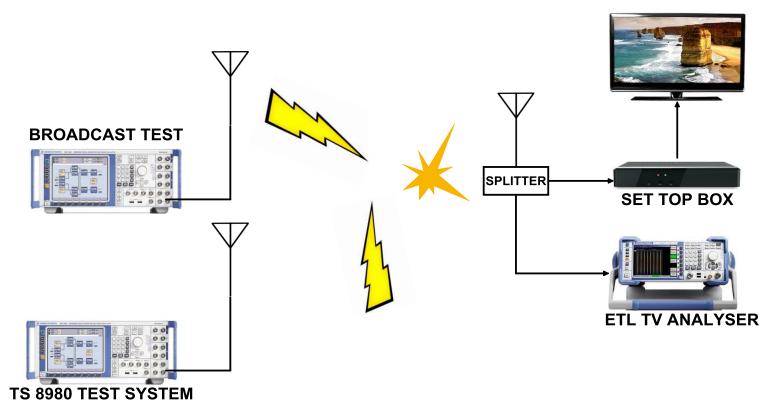


Spectrum Plan for 700MHz

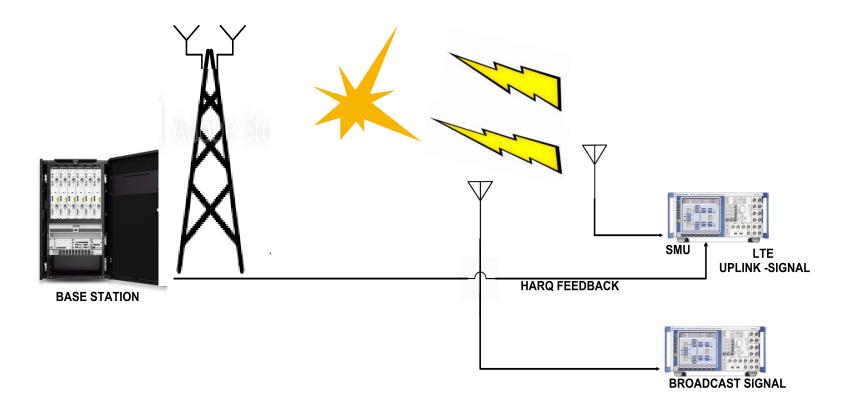

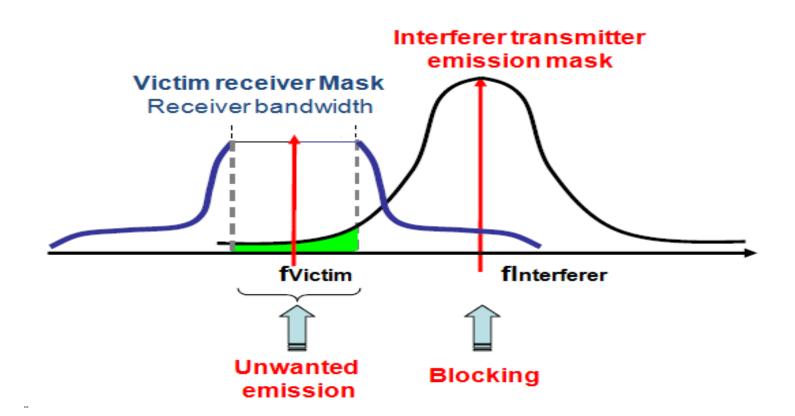

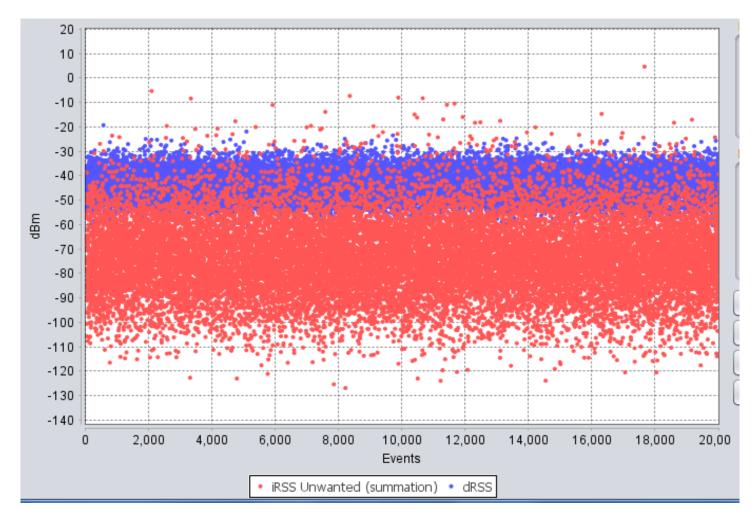
Field Measurement: Influence of LTE on DVB-T2



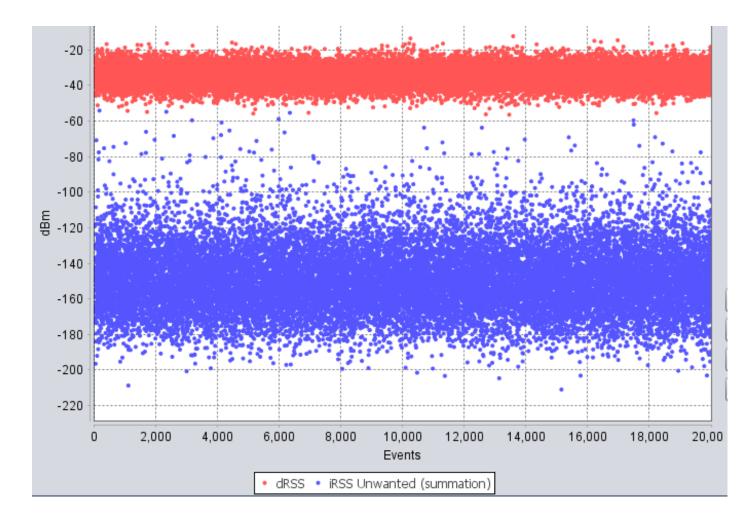
Field Measurement: Influence of DVB-T2 on LTE



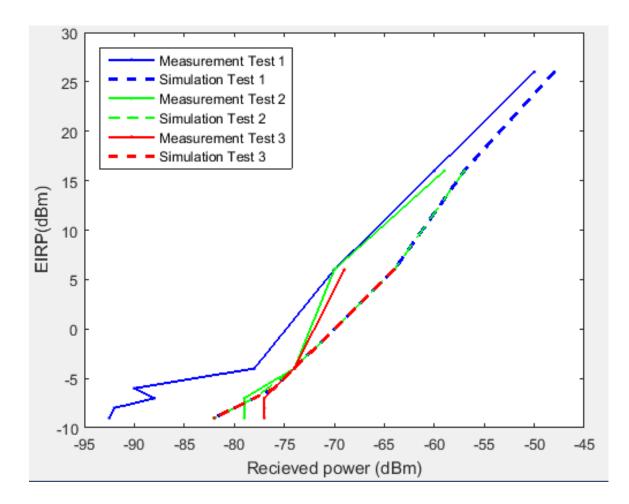

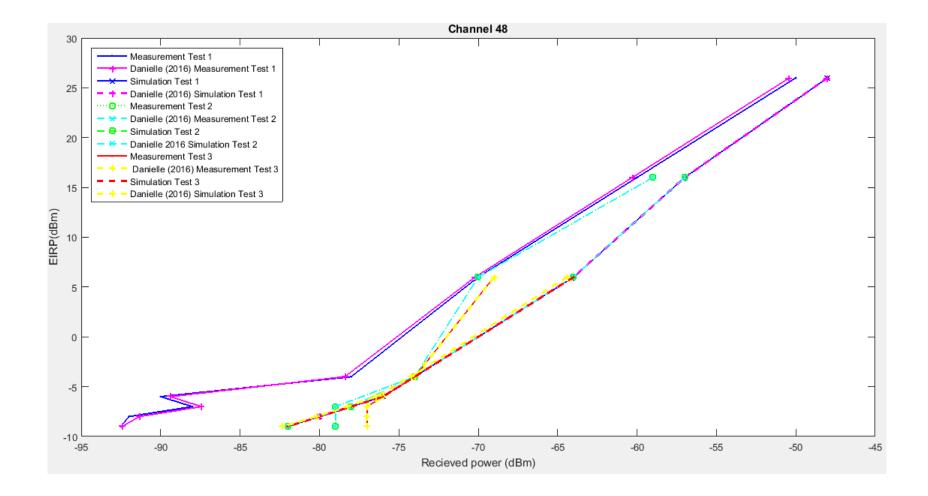
