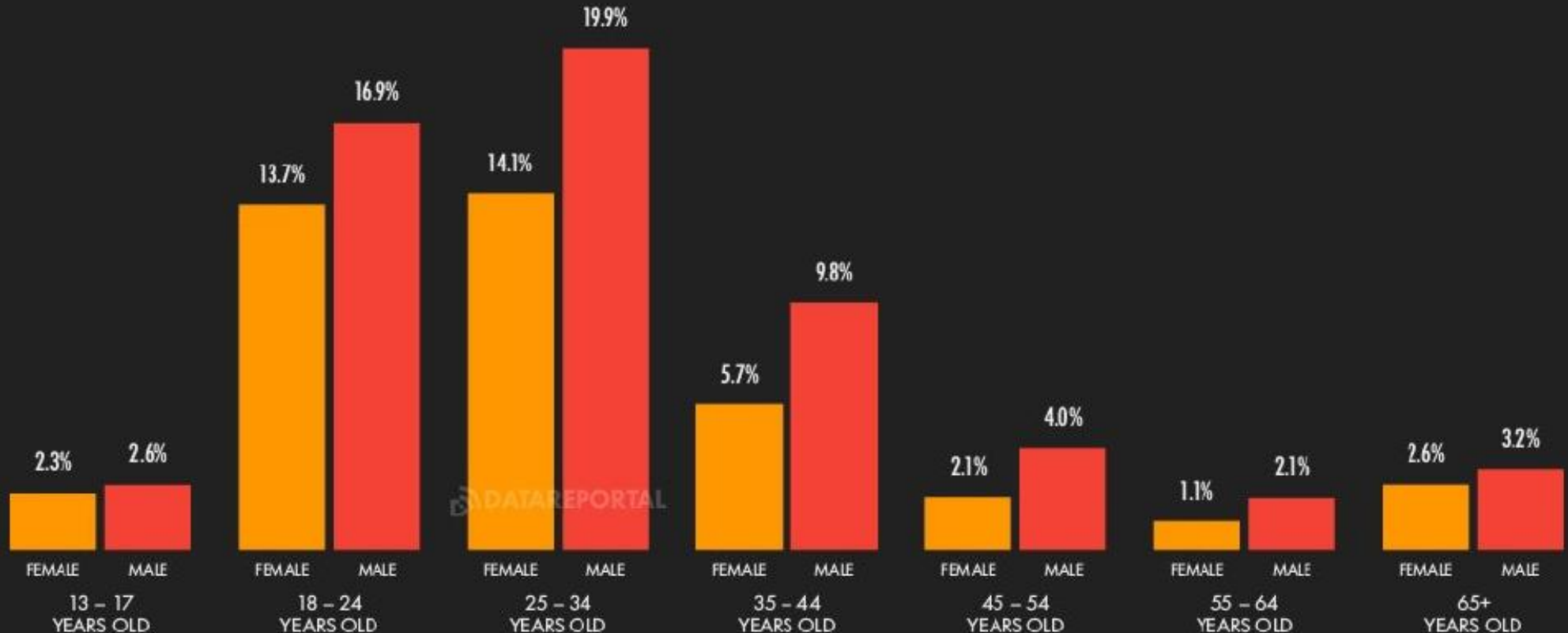

KEY FINDINGS

Connected:

51% of the world's population are now **using mobile internet**

93% of the world's **unconnected** population live in **low- and middle-income countries**

6% of the world's population are not covered by mobile broadband

43% of the world's population are not using mobile internet

450m people with progress slowing to cover the remaining

3.4bn people despite living in areas with mobile broadband coverage -

Global 5G coverage increased to **17%** in 2020

Despite the increase in data usage resulting from the pandemic, mobile networks were resilient and network capacity improved

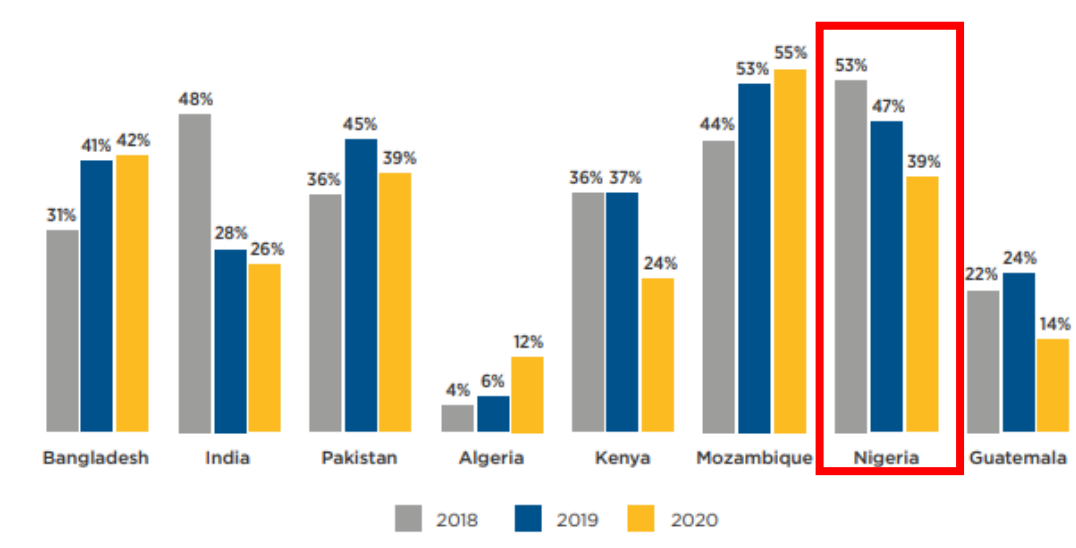

IMT2020

- In the World Radio communication Conference 2015 hold in Geneva, Switzerland, ITU-R officially approved three resolutions to facilitate the future 5G research process and formally determined the name of 5G is "IMT-2020“.
- **5G** (from "5th Generation") is the latest generation of cellular mobile communications. It succeeds the 4G(LTE-A, WiMax), 3G (UMTS, LTE) and 2G (GSM) systems. 5G performance targets high data rate, reduced latency, energy saving, cost reduction, higher system capacity, and massive device connectivity. The first phase of 5G specifications in Release-15 will be completed by April 2019 to accommodate the early commercial deployment. The second phase in Release-16 is due to be completed by April 2020 for submission to the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) as a candidate of IMT-2020 technology.

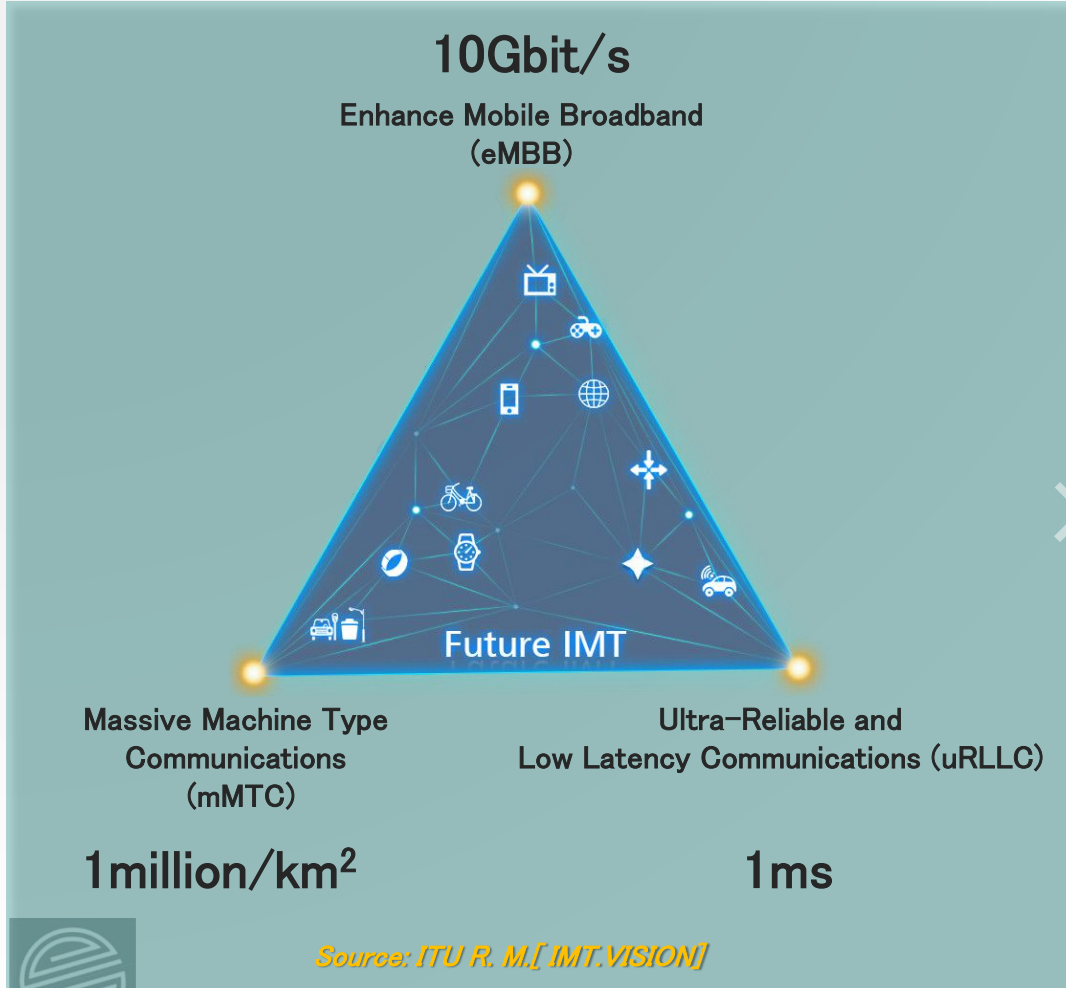

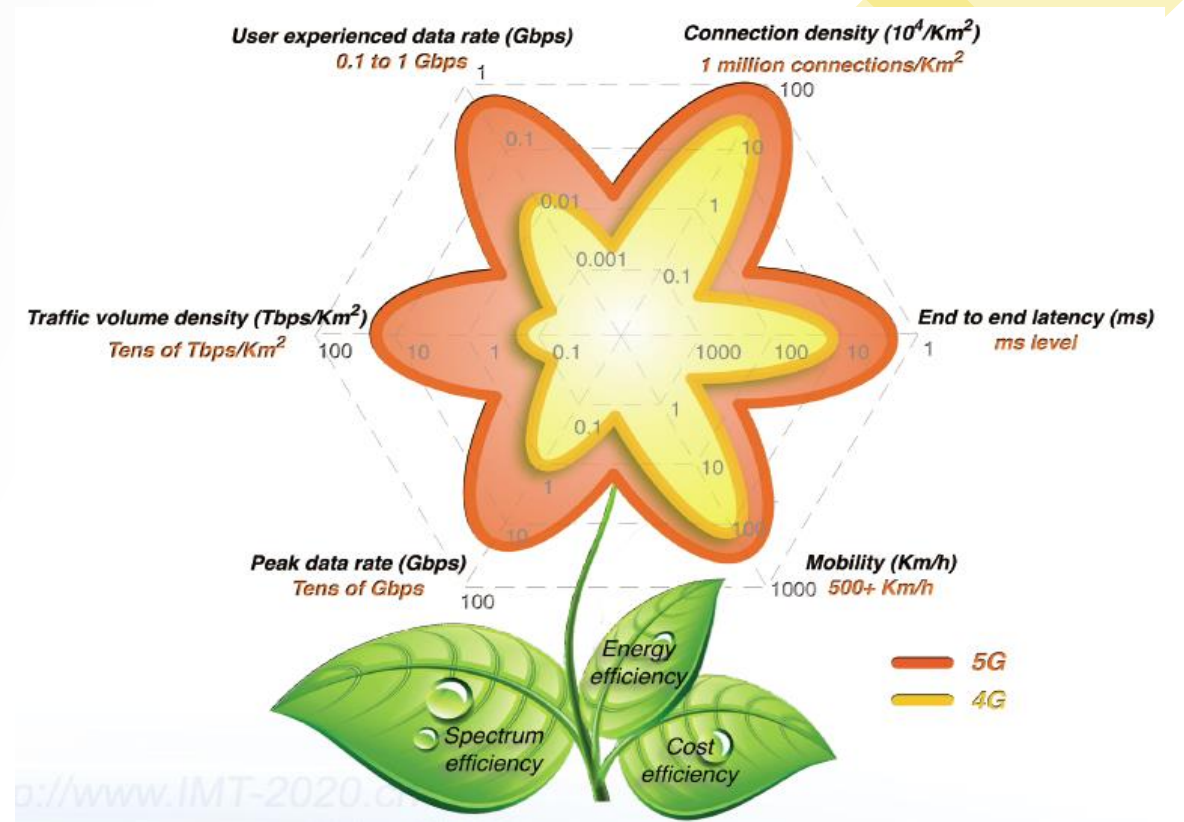
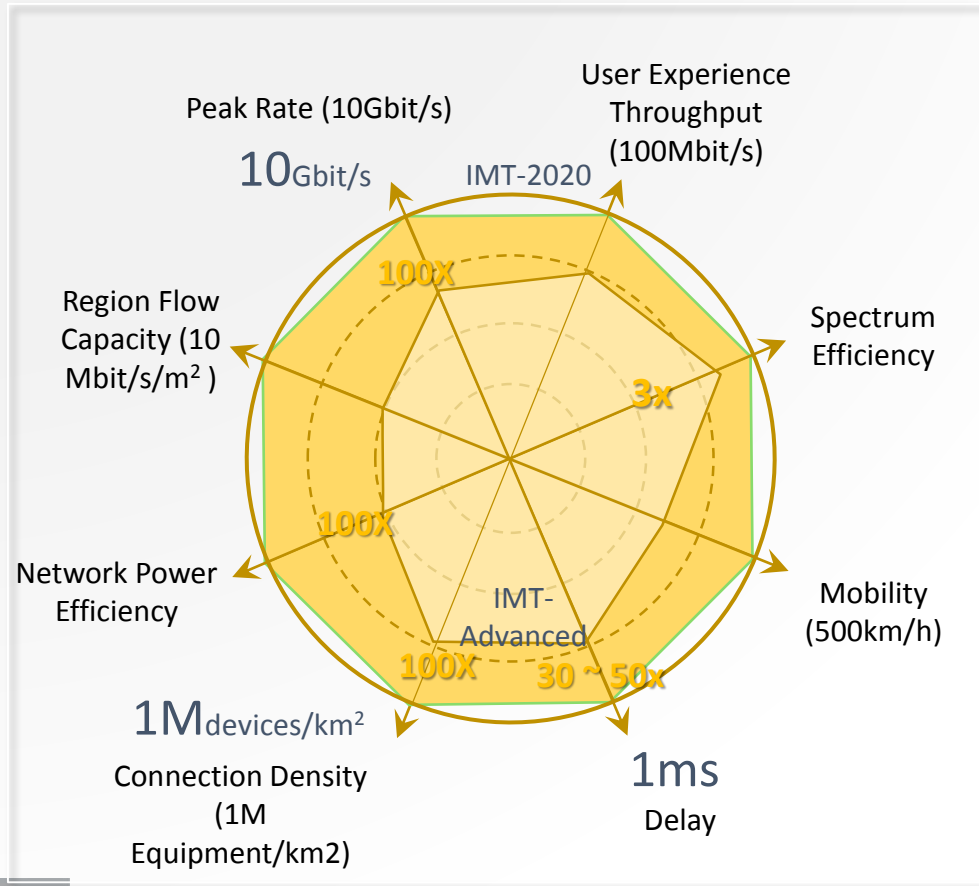
